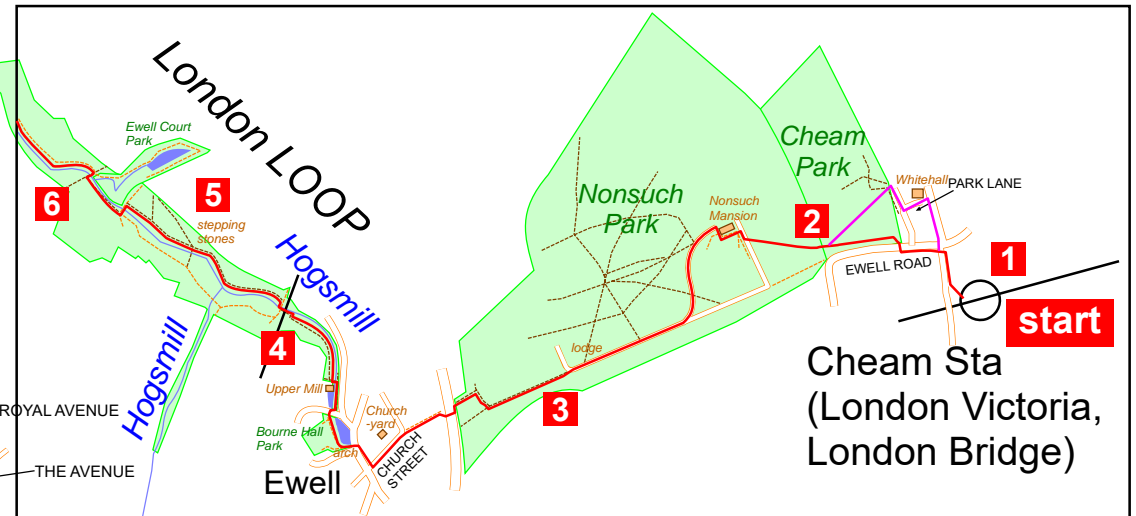


- 1** Leave station via pedestrian route on platform 1
- 2** Follow track inside the park. Cross through to Nonsuch Park and take a diagonal to the brick wall and take garden entrance. Exit via metalled path which leads to straight track where London LOOP joins.
- 3** Past the lodge the main path curves right. Ignore this and continue forwards on minor path past numbered columns. At column 5 turn right down a windy path. Follow LOOP left to bottom of field to exit.

- 4** The path takes a footbridge under the railway to a cross path. Turn right then left to follow the Hogsmill on your left. Optionally turn left then right to explore the meadows on the other side.
- 5** At the stepping stones, the meadow swings right but continue forward into the shrubbery and keep the river immediately left.
- 6** The path ends at a T junction. Turn left across the river and follow down to the next bridge where the path reverts to the right of the river, and stays there until busy main road, note 7



- 7** Here walk right to pick up the pedestrian lights and returning, cross the river so it is on your right, separated from a go-kart track by a high fence
- 8** The path exits onto a lane. Turn right and up Cromwell Road, left into Grafton Road and left into Royal Avenue at the top of a hill. Keep straight ahead by a combination of road and path. Exiting on main road turn right and left to pass a church. Proceed through a gate and then left down a path to reach the river. Turn right without crossing and keep close to the river
- 9** A busy divided road. Turn left up the hill to a pedestrian subway and return, entering ElmbridgeMeadows with the river on your right.

The upper Hogsmill is a pleasant walk; in the lower half there are two unavoidable irritating diversions.
